

## A Level and Level 3 Post Results Services

This information is taken from the JCQ Post Results Services publication summarising the post-results services offered by the JCQ member awarding bodies. These services are:

- **Review of results (RoR):** clerical re-check; review of marking; review of moderation
- **Access to scripts (ATS):** access to marked examination scripts

Service	What this includes	Deadline for completion
<b>RoR Service 1 Clerical re-check</b>	<p>This is a re-check of all clerical procedures leading to the issue of a result.</p> <p>This service will include the following checks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• that all parts of the script have been marked;</li> <li>• the totalling of marks;</li> <li>• the recording of marks.</li> </ul> <p>The outcome of the clerical re-check will be reported along with a statement of the total marks awarded for each unit, or component, included in the enquiry.</p>	<p>Within <b>10 calendar days</b> of the awarding body receiving the request.</p>
<b>RoR Priority Service 2 Review of marking</b>	<p>This is a priority review of the original marking to ensure that the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly. <b>It is not a re-marking of your script.</b></p> <p>This service will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the clerical re-checks detailed in Service 1;</li> <li>• a review of marking as described above.</li> </ul>	<p>Within <b>15 calendar days</b> of the awarding body receiving the request.</p>
<b>RoR Service 2 Review of marking</b>	<p>This is a post-results review of the original marking to ensure that the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly. <b>It is not a re-marking of your script.</b></p> <p>This service will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the clerical re-checks detailed in Service 1;</li> <li>• a review of marking as described above.</li> </ul>	<p>Within <b>20 calendar days</b> of the awarding body receiving the request.</p>
<b>RoR Service 3 Review of moderation</b>	<p>This is a review of the original moderation to ensure that the assessment criteria have been fairly, reliably and consistently applied. <b>It is not a re-moderation of candidates' work.</b></p> <p>The review of moderation will be undertaken on the original sample of candidates' work.</p> <p>A review of moderation cannot be undertaken upon the work of an individual candidate or the work of candidates not in the original sample.</p>	<p>Within <b>35 calendar days</b> of the moderator receiving the original sample of work from the centre.</p>
<b>ATS</b>	<p>Students may request:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• copies of scripts to support reviews of marking</li> </ul>	<p>To be received by <b>8<sup>th</sup> September 2022</b></p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• copies of scripts to support teaching and learning</li> </ul>	<p>To be received by <b>29<sup>th</sup> September 2022</b></p>
