### **October Half Term - Lateral Flow Testing at Home and Covid Vaccinations**

Thank you for your support with Covid-19 home testing. Moving to everyday Lateral Flow Testing during this last week of term has picked up a number of additional positive cases and so will have reduced transmission.

As a school community, we are very grateful for this, as we want to do everything we can to minimise the risk, so that we keep as many students in school as possible during this challenging time.

#### Lateral Flow Testing during Half Term Holiday

Throughout the October half-term school holiday, please encourage and support your children to continue testing at home and report results twice a week on Test Register and to the NHS. All results should be reported, even if your result is negative or void.

**To support a safe return to school on Monday 1 November, your child should take an additional test, so they will test on two consecutive days before coming back into school – either on Saturday and Sunday or Sunday and Monday morning. Please remember to report the result on Test Register and report absence using Study Bugs.**

Your children should have already collected additional home test kits. If you do still require more home testing kits, you can order more through [gov.uk](http://gov.uk) or collect from your local pharmacy.
