PE Kit Reset

Since March 2020 our young people and your families have experienced a significant level of disruption across almost every facet of daily life. Since returning from successive lockdowns the school has permitted some relaxation to certain areas of School life, such as PE Kit.

From January we are introducing a PE kit reset. For all core PE lessons the following items will be essential:

- BFS polo
- Sports trainers
- Plain navy bottoms (any **one** of the following: shorts/skort/sports leggings/joggers)
- Long navy socks
- Shin pads

Optional PE kit items that are permitted:

- Plain navy jumper/sweatshirt – no hood
- BFS extra-curricular sports hoody
- Navy and red rugby shirt
- Additional navy bottoms (shorts/skort/sports leggings/joggers)
- Thermal base layers
- In cold weather, students may wear hats, gloves and coats (depending on the sport being delivered)

Recommended kit (students will need these to participate fully in football and rugby. These will be compulsory from September 2022):

- Football/rugby boots
- Gum shields

PE items not allowed:

- Items with big sports logos
- Items that aren't navy blue (i.e. no black/grey)
- Full zipped jumpers/jackets
- Fashion leggings (e.g. cotton leggings)
- Fashion trainers
- Tights
- School jumpers

NOTE: If you have purchased kit especially for this academic year that is black it may be used up until the end of the School year. **From September 2022 PE kit will be back to navy only.**
