Sports Day Arrangements: Monday 11 July – Years 9 and Year 10

Tuesday 12 July - Years 7 and Year 8

We are delighted to confirm the arrangements for this year's Sports Day events which will take place over two days at Cotham School Stoke Lodge Playing Fields, Shirehampton Road, Bristol, BS9 1BN

On the day of their year group's events, students should study at home from 8.30am to 10.15am. They will have a remote tutor session on TEAMS at 8.30am and they will have tasks to complete for Period 1 and Period 2 which are set on Class Charts.

<u>Students should eat a "brunch" at home</u> and then make their way straight to Stoke Lodge for registration for their Sports Day at 11.00am.

Sports day activities will commence at 11.15am and will finish at 2.30pm, when students will be dismissed from Stoke Lodge.

## **Transport and Lunch Request Form**

There will be a limited number of spaces available on the school minibus for students unable to get to Stoke Lodge themselves. This will depart from BFS at 10.45am promptly and will depart from Stoke Lodge at 2.30pm. Please complete the form if your child requires transport to Stoke Lodge.

It is expected that students will eat at home before they arrive, but should your child be entitled to Free School Meals and you would like a lunch provided, please indicate on the form.

## **Kit and Medication**

Students should eat at home, so should be no need for food to be brought to the event, but they should bring a full water bottle and any medication they would normally carry with them. We are expecting good weather so please also apply sun cream beforehand at home and students should wear a hat.

If the School holds an epi-pen, inhaler or any prescription medicine taken on a daily basis this will be available for your child at Stoke Lodge. No other medicines will be taken, so if anything such as paracetamol or anti-histamines may be required please administer this at home.

Students are required to wear their BFS PE kit, their house colour or a mixture of both. Ashton – yellow: Blaise – red Canford – blue: Durdham – green All clothing must be appropriate for sporting activities. In the event of cancellation, parents/carers will be notified by text message and Class Charts before 7:00 am on the day and students will be expected in school for 8.25am.
