#### Words from the Headteacher

Bristol Free School and ICT

At Bristol Free School we have a well-established and up-to-date Microsoft Network which is managed for us by JosKos IT Solutions who work with all RET schools. Below is an outline of the ICT infrastructure at Bristol Free School.

Every student has their own username and password providing them with access to the school network: filtered internet; a private file store; and shared file repositories. The internet connection is filtered to ensure that students are able only to access suitable material. It is monitored closely and is supported by "Smoothwall" which applies updates to the restrictions. Students are also supplied with an email address consisting of their username e.g. a.person14 followed by @bristolfreeschool.org.uk. This email service is provided by "Google for Education". Students can take advantage of single sign-on for the VLE and their email by visiting the School's website, clicking on VLE and using their network username and password.

For staff it is important that we have access to timely information which aids us in supporting students through school. Tutors use "The Tracker" which allows them to monitor attendance, achievements and behaviour points. During weekly tutorials tutors can use this information to generate targets for the forthcoming week. All teachers use "Class Charts" to generate seating plans and to ensure constructive and positive relationships are encouraged during lessons. Finally, teachers are able to use "Impero" to monitor student ICT equipment during lessons making sure that these are being used appropriately for the purposes of learning.

At Bristol Free School we value the contribution which parents are able to make to support our students in their learning. Every parent has (or will receive) a parent link login for the VLE. This provides access to attendance, progress reports, achievements and behaviour points. Parents and students have (or will receive) logins for "Show My Homework". This programme provides the school with an alternative method for communicating work to be done, resources required and grading of homework. We hope you find this service particularly useful – we do. "Show My Homework" has a very useful app and we encourage all students and parents to install it on their smart devices. It provides timely notifications and reminders of homework which is due for completion.

The School has an online payment system which may be used to load funds onto your child's catering account as well as for making payments for most residential and day trips your child goes on. We feel this is a safer and more secure way of making payments than students walking around with cash. We recommend that you create an account for online payments. Please email <a href="mailto:admin@bristolfreeschool.org.uk">admin@bristolfreeschool.org.uk</a> if you need a code to set up an account.
