On this course you will develop:

- The ability to explore elements of visual language, line, form, pattern, colour and texture in the context of photography
- Understanding of techniques related to the production of photographic images plus presentation and layout
- The ability to respond to an issue, theme, concept or idea, or work to a brief or answer a need in photography
- The ability to understand the historical and contemporary developments and the styles and genres of photography

Task 1 – Photography Summer Challenge

Document one week of your summer break. Look at how photographers have photographed the world around them. Martin Parr, Toby Binder, Robert Frank. This task will help you to develop and experiment with your storytelling and gain experience exploring composition, using photography in a creative way.
